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Notes on sewer connection applications

Please Note that all existing or proposed premises and developments for which planning permission is required under the Planning Acts must have full planning permission prior to granting a connection.

All non domestic connections shall require a discharge licence from the sanitary authority.

All statutory charges and levies shall be paid in full prior to granting the connection.

All discharges to surface water systems which discharge to rivers or streams shall require a licence from Wicklow County Council.

All works proposals and above details shall be agreed with the Sanitary Engineer prior to commencement of work.

The final connection to the sewers and drainage system shall be notified to the Town Overseer 7 days prior to making the connection.

The final works shall be inspected and overseen by the Councils Town Overseer and signed off as satisfactory prior to allowing any discharge from the development into the sewer/drainage network.

Where works are proposed in the public road or open space a separate Road opening licence shall be required, and shall accompany this application.
